Our Commitments

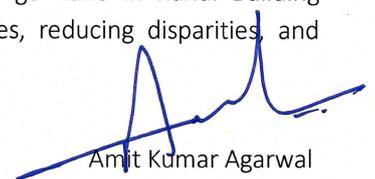
